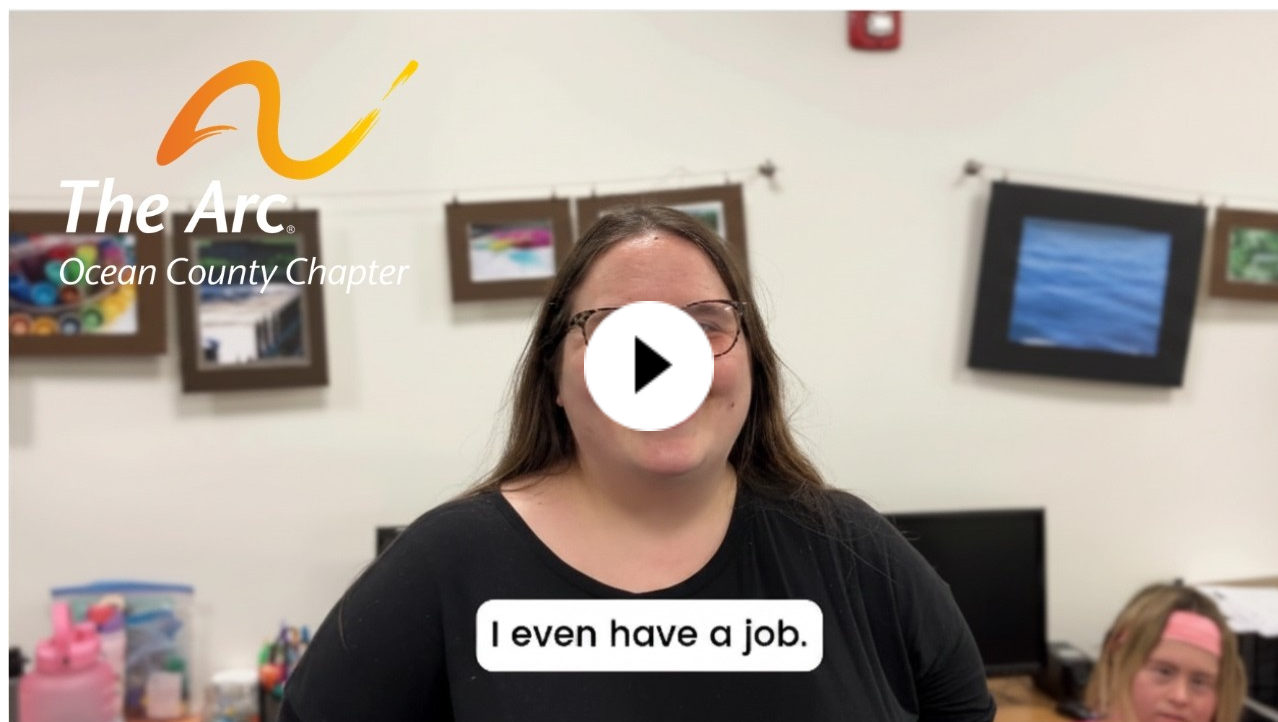




The Arc's Programs and Services
