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<u>Virtual Recreation Activity Descriptions</u>

<u>Bingo</u>: Join us every Tuesday from 6:00pm-7:00pm to play a virtual game of Bingo. Participants can make their own bingo card by writing 24 animals from the provided list in the boxes, or print out a provided bingo card with pictures of animals. Words will be drawn from a hat by the activity leader, and participants will mark their boards with coins/buttons until they get Bingo.

<u>Karaoke</u>: Join us every Wednesday from 3:00pm-4:00pm and sing along to your favorite songs at a virtual Karaoke session. Participants must submit their song requests ahead of time in the event registrations.

<u>Thursday Theme Dance</u>: Dance along to your favorite songs for 1 hour at our themed dances. The theme will be voted and announced on social media. Feel free to leave your song request in the registration, and have fun with the theme by dressing up!

<u>Would You Rather:</u> Play a virtual game of Would You Rather by choosing 1 of the 2 theoretical options given to you by the activity leader and explaining why you choose it. Example: Would you rather eat a cookie or eat or cupcake?

<u>Hangman:</u> Play a virtual game of hangman by guessing one letter at a time, when called on by the activity leader, to try to figure out what the mystery word is.

<u>Mad Libs:</u> Play a virtual fill in the blank story game called Mad Libs by giving examples of nouns, adjectives and verbs to the activity leader when called on. These different words will fill in the blanks to a fun story that will be read out loud. Need some help thinking of words? Print out a list of fun examples of nouns, adjectives and verbs below.

<u>Name That Tune:</u> Play a virtual music guessing game called Name that Tune by listening to a short clip of a song and guessing the name, artists or lyrics.

iSpy: Play a virtual game of iSpy by looking at the activity leader's screen and guessing what the mystery object is.

<u>Spot the Difference:</u> Play a virtual game of Spot the Difference by paying close attention to the activity leader's screen, who will shut off their camera for 30 seconds to change objects around, then turn the camera back on. Participants will then search for anything different in the room and raise their hand when they find the change.

<u>Disney Name that Tune:</u> Play a Disney themed virtual music guessing game called Name that Tune by listening to a short clip of a song and guessing the name, artist, or what movie the song is from.

Pictionary: Play a virtual game of Pictionary by guessing what word the activity leader is drawing.

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<u>20 Questions:</u> Play a virtual game of 20 Questions by asking yes or no questions to the activity leader to try to guess the mystery animal. Example: ask questions like "does this animal have 4 legs?" "does this animal have fur?" "does this animal fly?" "does this animal live under water?"

Disney Trivia: Play a virtual trivia game by answering multiple choice questions about different Disney movies and shows.

<u>Rock Paper Scissors:</u> Play a virtual game of Rock Paper Scissors with your friends. Set up in a tournament style, 2 participants at a time will play Rock Paper Scissors, where the winner will move onto the next round until there is only 1 winner.

Origami: Follow along to a step-by-step origami class lead by the activity leader.

<u>Fireside Chat:</u> Join us as we talk about what we did during the week at our fireside chats. A virtual video of a fire will play in the background as one participant at a time will talk about what activities they did during the week, what their favorite part of the week was, any upcoming weekend plans and overall anything they want to share.

<u>Movie Review:</u> Join us as we talk about the previous week's recommended movie. Topics such as your favorite scene, favorite character, and favorite song will be discussed. We will also answer some trivia questions.

<u>Art Share:</u> Join us as we hold a show and tell session specifically for our art. Each participant will have 5 minutes to explain what piece of art they brought, where they made it, when they made it, why they made it and how they made it.

<u>Coloring Book Club:</u> Virtually color with your friends while listening to music. Participants will provide their own coloring book materials and share their masterpiece at the end of the session.

<u>Show and Tell:</u> Join us as we hold a classic show and tell session with our friends. Each participant will have 5 minutes to show what they brought, explain what it is, why they brought it and any fun facts about it.

Sign Language: Join us as we learn the American Sign Language (ASL) alphabet one letter at a time.
